Patches volunteering for Sept newcomer's.

<u>Chronicler</u> (Teleri): June newsletter out on time with two articles from the populace. Seeking Pennsic Pity activities for July.

<u>Herald</u> (Patricia): Needs to do court report for Highland River Melees, their Excelencies of Storvik presented some awards at that event. Still needs to talk to Triton about getting a replacement. Got some submissions from someone at fight practice, is doing research.
