

# Officer's Reports

<u>Seneschal</u>: Working on quarterly report, will collect zip codes to get ready for polling next year. Need 6 mo notice to set up polling, so will bring things back up in January with their Excellencies. Rayhana will renew warrant for another 2 years, then must step down.

<u>Exchequer</u>: End of Sept, \$8594.45 on bank statement. Not yet received BotB funds, approx \$1000. No bank fees for the month. Will have to pay practice hall quarterly fees, reimburse Teleri for meeting space.

Rayhana moved to reimburse \$75 Teleri for hall, all aye.

Rayhana move to meet here next month, all aye, will prepay Canterbury Riding Association

<u>MOAS</u>: (via email) Have held dance classes, Roman clothing class. Cameron the Grey did arrow-making and leatherworking classes, Griele did silk painting. Bookbinding at the Early Northern European Adhocracy night.

#### Storvik Means Fire

You may have heard that "Storvik means fire!" Folks tend to shout it at random intervals. I used to think it came from the 'pillars of flame,' the tall propane torches used for light at night.

Nope.

Baron Sean DeLaMar told the story once in my hearing, and any omissions or errors are my own.

Once upon a time, some brave fighting men of Storvik – I believe they were House Blackspear – came upon a very pitiful sight. Some gentles were trying to start a campfire, and it was... small. Dim. Unimpressive.

The lords of Storvik asked if they could assist, and soon a tower of boughs was constructed. No mere lean-to of twigs, no, not this. 


**Newcomer's Night** in Silver Spring: 7981 Eastern Ave, Silver Spring MD 20910.
