Crown/Kingdom Sites: there is a possible kids' camp in Gaitherburg. \$2,000/day, camping friendly. 2,000 is within Kingdom budget. Would be in Roxbury Mills, so Chatelaine should talk to the Seneschal of RM. Send other possible sites to Kunigunde.

New Business

Spring Fair: It was reported that we could not drive into inner area (possible problem). Contract not yet gotten. Question raised about whether Spring Faire is inside advertising window for this year. Vote to postpone until 2020 passed.

Battle on the Bay: Things are going smoothly. Dates are 9/6-9/8. \$1200+\$100 deposit site fee (\$400/day, 8 AM-6 PM). \$100/day overnight (7PM-9 AM) reserved for (7 pm Friday - 6 PM Sunday). Reserving it earlier is Lochmere's decision. BotB 2020 dates 9/4-9/6; vote to pay \$600 (\$500 site fee plus maybe \$100 for deposit) to add Labor Day 2020 as an expense passes.

Loaner Armor: 4 of the loaner armor helmets need new padding, new straps. Heavy loaner armor onsite at fighter practices needs serious work (maybe done at at-homes?). List needed of what needs to be done; her Excellency will talk to Quartermaster on this.

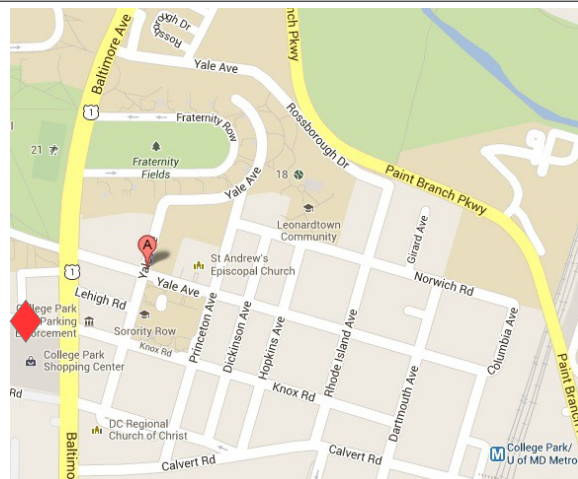

Release Forms

Want to share something in the Drekkar? Give me legal permission to do so!

[Grant of Use Form](#): For articles, non-photograph artwork, most other contributions

[Model Release Form](#): People appearing in photographs must sign this if:

1. The image is portrait-style
2. The photograph is taken in a private space at an event (such as a personal encampment)
3. The photograph is taken at a non-public venue (such as an armor-making workshop at a home)

No model release form is needed when the photograph is taken at a public place and in a public forum

(where there is no expectation of privacy), including:

- any SCA contest or competition, merchants' row, court, class, etc.

[Photo Release Form](#): The photographer who takes a picture (of anything or anyone) must sign a release form.
