The Conquest of Naples by Charles of Durazzo, 1381-82

"Painted in Florence about 1400, this elaborately decorated front of a chest (cassone) recounts in three episodes the conquest of Naples by Charles III of Durazzo, who defeated the forces of Otto of Brunswick in 1381. At the right, the armies clash; in the center, Otto's troops (recognizable by their distinctive haircut) surrender to Charles; at the left, the victors enter the conquered city. The prominent pennants and coats of arms in the spandrels are those of the Durazzo and the kings of Hungary." Left unmentioned: popes, anti-popes, schisms, excommunications, dynastic squabbling that often only ended with a lack of viable offspring, and several assassinations. Ruling Naples was apparently not for the timid.



Release Forms

Want to share something in the Drekkar? Give me legal permission to do so!

Grant of Use Form: For articles, non-photograph artwork, most other contributions

Model Release Form: People appearing in photographs must sign this if:

1. The image is portrait-style

Catonsville MD

- 2. The photograph is taken in a private space at an event (such as a personal encampment)
- 3. The photograph is taken at a non-public venue (such as an armor-making workshop at a home)

No model release form is needed when the photograph is taken at a public place and in a public forum

(where there is no expectation of privacy), including:

- any SCA contest or competition, merchants' row, court, class, etc.

<u>Photo Release Form</u>: The photographer who takes a picture (of anything or anyone) must sign a release form.
