- As of January 2020 approximately \$11,400 is in the bank.
- There are two outstanding checks totaling \$43.76
- The bad check written at coronation is still outstanding. the lady contacted me via email in response to my letter and I sent her information but never heard back.
- Domesday report got accepted and I have not heard any issues with it.
- 2019 summary: Barony made net \$1,024 for the year, \$13,200 of income, and \$12,176 of expenses.
- Our largest type of expense was site rentals, which cost us \$5,830; other large expenses included Equipment purchases and food for feasts.
- We had \$12,918 available cash at the end of the year.
- Practice Rental - Costs \$3,400; we get approximately \$1,500 in donations to help cover the costs.
- We still need to meet to finish bylaws.
- I need to send the updated signature change form to Corporate SCA. Busy season is busy, so might not be until March/April.
- Expense check for PO Box rental for 1 year cut for \$140 (reimbursing Karen Flessas).



[Grant of Use Form](#): For articles, non-photograph artwork, most other contributions

[Model Release Form](#): People appearing in photographs must sign this if:

1. The image is portrait-style
2. The photograph is taken in a private space at an event (such as a personal encampment)
3. The photograph is taken at a non-public venue (such as an armor-making workshop at a home)

No model release form is needed when the photograph is taken at a public place and in a public forum

(where there is no expectation of privacy), including:

- any SCA contest or competition, merchants' row, court, class, etc.

[Photo Release Form](#): The photographer who takes a picture (of anything or anyone) must sign a release form.
