Courtiers in a Rose Garden: A Lady and Two Gentlemen, ca. 1440–50, South Netherlandish (Tapestry) "This work belongs to a series of tapestries designed to cover the walls of an entire room. Such sets were often referred to in medieval inventories as "rooms" ("chambres"). It is possible that this set was made for the French king Charles VII, whose colors were white, red, and green and one of whose emblems was the rose tree. A royal connection is certainly likely, for the tapestries are sumptuous, with metal threads not only in the clothing and jewelry worn by the fashionable courtiers and ladies, but also in the background leaves, buds, and open roses."

Events:

Discussion on opening up. Points raised:

- Observation: Ponte Alto has been doing outdoor activities; wants to know how that's been working with them.
- Some support for a hard rule for vaccination.
- Suggestion that no under-18s until further notice.
- Statement: not doing events until vaccinated; no activities should be done until June.
- Some people on the pessimistic side for activities.
- Observation: can't see how we can do fighter practices under the current system because of different groups. Hesitant about Novice.
- Seneschal notes that official events require contact tracing. We will need to hash out the procedures ahead of time, probably online.
- Observation: youths are a complicating factor.
- Observation: has mixed feelings on reopening. We are in a weird period with different levels of vaccinations.
- Observation: the entire issue has been politicized, so vaccinations themselves may be an issue. Is uncomfortable with bringing a child to large events at this point of time.
- Baron: the Kingdom and SCA will need to clarify guidelines. We will need to keep a tight ship on events. We should keep things local and see how things operate on that level. Baronage does not expect volunteers to volunteer if they're concerned.
- Observation: should we even let under-18 year olds attend at this point? Some agreement to that.
- Suggestion: no-contact thermometers. Worried about long-term vaccination efficacy. Pessimistic about June event.
- Baroness: issue on how long for immunity to take, but three months is the current number.
- Baron: what about Pennsic? Also: we can't look at vaccination cards.
- Suggestion: we should look at hard benchmarks.
- Observation: camping does have unique issues with hygiene.

- Novice 2021: Autocrat/Seneschal is ready to turn it virtual if necessary. Autocrat (Alicia) working on contingency plans with regard to COVID. Will go back to the drawing board. Has a budget, but will reassess it because of the above conversation. Open to suggestions. Very open; this is her first event. Seneschal wants to at least have conditional approval on it. MoL: we HAVE to do the budget this month. Chatelaine: thinks 100 is too many. Tentative, provisional budget passes by show of hands. Autocrat will call the office for site to determine what their requirements are.
- AwesomeCon: Baronage thinks it's still going to be virtual. Chatelaine thinks we should do virtual stuff there; has already put in for a dance class.
- BotB 2021: Nothing to report.
- Worldcon: up in the air. Chatelaine has put in for a dance class.

Old Business:

- Financial Policy to be discussed offline.
- We need a deputy chronicler.

New Business:

- Alicia needs volunteers for the event. Seneschal notes that maybe we want to note that volunteers get to, you know, go.
- Baron thinks all officers should review COVID rules on Atlantia website.
- April 2nd is next Maugie concert.

Grant of Use Form: For articles, non-photograph artwork, most other contributions

Model Release Form: People appearing in photographs must sign this if:

- 1. The image is portrait-style
- 2. The photograph is taken in a private space at an event (such as a personal encampment)
- 3. The photograph is taken at a non-public venue (such as an armor-making workshop at a home)

No model release form is needed when the photograph is taken at a public place and in a public forum

(where there is no expectation of privacy), including:

- any SCA contest or competition, merchants' row, court, class, etc.

<u>Photo Release Form</u>: The photographer who takes a picture (of anything or anyone) must sign a release form.
