Events:

- Awesomecon: reimbursement checks handed off to Celric
- BotB: Excheq/Dep Excheq fixed SCARS SNAFU. \$4,314 profit, split with Lochmere. Need to simplify SCARS procedures. Excheq recommends keeping the Croom deposit check (currently \$350) on file, because of mail unreliability. SM checked; we're running event at Croom in spring (Novice).

Old Business:

- Signature business with the bank: put on hold until new Excheq.
- Financial policy: Excheq hasn't heard back yet
- Spring coronation bid: Deputy Seneschal working on budget, trying to lock down cook. Going to try to get the bid to the committee by Wednesday. Motion to finalize bid passes.

New Business:

- Unevent in two weeks. Fully virtual.
- January the Storvik mailbox expires. Should we renew it? Dep Excheq will continue to maintain the mailbox, if we want it. General consensus is that we want it for convenience and a standard baronial address. Motion to allocate \$200 for mailbox passes.
- Fighter practice 12/27? No indication yet that the church would cancel, but we might. Will reach out to KM.
- ChessieCon: virtual, free, encourage donation. Storvikis will be teaching dance, doing poems set to original music, and harp.

Meeting adjourned 8:10 PM. Next meeting on December 19th, 7-9 PM, location TBD.

[Model Release Form](#): People appearing in photographs must sign this if:

1. The image is portrait-style
2. The photograph is taken in a private space at an event (such as a personal encampment)
3. The photograph is taken at a non-public venue (such as an armor-making workshop at a home)

No model release form is needed when the photograph is taken at a public place and in a public forum

(where there is no expectation of privacy), including:

- any SCA contest or competition, merchants' row, court, class, etc.

[Photo Release Form](#): The photographer who takes a picture (of anything or anyone) must sign a release form.
