The Triumph of Cherries



Girl with Cherries Attributed to Marco d'Oggiono (Italian, Milan ca. 1467–1524 Milan) Date: ca. 1491–95 Medium: Oil on wood

"Painted by Marco d'Oggiono, a close associate of Leonardo da Vinci's in Milan, this picture combines elements of portraiture and allegory. The richly dressed female wearing an inscrutable smile is crowned with ivy and holds a bowl of cherries. The meaning is enigmatic: it may allude to marriage (ivy symbolized marital fidelity) but also suggests a connection with sophisticated literary circles." ...Or maybe it suggests that the girl has fresh fruit, and is happy about it. I swear to God, sometimes it feels like the Met thinks they've let the side down if they don't come up with a complicated answer.

Chronicler suggested we vote on allowing budget for storage space. Social Media officer pointed out that we need to keep an eye on the rates for storage space; baroness agrees, we need flexibility. Seneschal offers point that we should consider replacing this at some point. Conclusion for now: we will stick them at Seneschal until after Novice, and then figure out what to do with it.

Grant of Use Form: For articles, non-photograph artwork, most other contributions

Model Release Form: People appearing in photographs must sign this if:

- 1. The image is portrait-style
- 2. The photograph is taken in a private space at an event (such as a personal encampment)
- 3. The photograph is taken at a non-public venue (such as an armor-making workshop at a home)

No model release form is needed when the photograph is taken at a public place and in a public forum

(where there is no expectation of privacy), including:

- any SCA contest or competition, merchants' row, court, class, etc.

<u>Photo Release Form</u>: The photographer who takes a picture (of anything or anyone) must sign a release form.
