Reminders from Master Celric, Storvik's Knight Marshal:

1) All non-members (those without a blue card) are **required** to sign the practice waiver prior to picking up a weapon.

2) If you are using loaner gear, especially armor, it needs to be inspected by a marshal to ensure it fits *your body* effectively prior to you fighting in it.

3) If there is a problem – i.e., weapon breaks, armor failures, injuries – Master Celric needs to be looped in every time.

Wordfame for those in Storvik's hall

Lady Órlaith Carey (known as Orla) and Lady Caitilín inghean Uí Ruaidhrí each received an Oar of Storvik from Thegn John and Thegn Graciela at Battle on the Bay. The Oar of Storvik honors "service of any type that goes above and beyond, most of which is often unseen or unheard but seamlessly is done for the enhancement of the Barony." **Vivat!**

Lord Jared of Storvik was made a Companion of the Lozulet at Battle on the Bay. The Lozulet is Storvik's service award; the Order dates back to the earliest days of the Barony. *Vivat!*

Baroness Ilaria de Gandia was awarded the Shield of Storvik at Battle on the Bay. The Shield honors those who have already received Baronial awards and continued to conspicuously serve the Barony. *Vivat!*
