Baronial News Highlights

Reminders from Master Celric, Storvik's Knight Marshal:

- 1) All non-members (those without a blue card) are **required** to sign the practice waiver prior to picking up a weapon.
- 2) If you are using loaner gear, especially armor, it needs to be inspected by a marshal to ensure it fits *your body* effectively prior to you fighting in it.
- 3) If there is a problem i.e., weapon breaks, armor failures, injuries Master Celric needs to be looped in every time.

 - Exchequer approves via email: If the armor sells please let me know for how much. Either you can get the monies to me or deposit it to the Group's account and save me the deposit slips.
- Attendance usually low Monday after Thanksgiving Sonya will ask whether the dancers want to use the hall. Proposal to cancel practice on Monday, December 23rd.

- Baronial progress Crown Tournament (John fighting) in Spiaggia, Highland Havoc, Holiday Faire.

Events:

- Cheverly: Teleri: October 26th will be a craft-oriented demo. Looking for folks to craft in public from 3-5 p.m. Looking for donations of cardboard bigger than 8.5 x 11 inches. Patches will take such donations at fighter practice.
- Yule Revel, December 21st, 2024: Event has been Spiked under Teleri's name, but the response message went to Marguerite's email.
- Novice/Battle on the Bay 2025: Intended dates are June 20-22 for Novice and first or second weekend in September for BotB.
- Performers' Revel: Could be at Cheverly? Maybe have performances outside. We have a
 reservation for late March but that would make outside performances potentially a challenge.
 There is also a conference room. Sonya is willing to autocrat. Want to loop in Fevronia and
 Igor, who previously hosted the Revel. Consensus date is March 22 to avoid conflict with
 Defending the Gate on March 29.

Old Business:

Teleri: Rose was scoping out Rock Creek Park as a location for possible demos. Celric pointed
out that the Park Service might have strict weapons rules that would prevent archery, thrown
weapons, potentially fighting. Also need to keep other things in mind as we scout out sites:
accessibility, alcohol policy, etc.

New Business:

- Spiaggia Levantina wishes to borrow our list fence for Crown Tournament. They will try to find someone to transport it.
 - Teleri proposes we let them borrow it, Marguerite seconds, motion passes.
- Approve \$100 for the construction of new list fence pieces to replace the old and busted ones
 prior to Crown Tournament, Teleri motions, Sonya seconded. Motion passes BUT requires
 Exchequer approval for release of funds.

Teleri ended the meeting at 8:05 p.m. Next meeting: November 17th on Zoom.

Grant of Use Form: For articles, non-photograph artwork, most other contributions

Model Release Form: People appearing in photographs must sign this if:

- 1. The image is portrait-style
- 2. The photograph is taken in a private space at an event (such as a personal encampment)
- 3. The photograph is taken at a non-public venue (such as an armor-making workshop at a home)

No model release form is needed when the photograph is taken at a public place and in a public forum (where there is no expectation of privacy), including: any SCA contest or competition, merchants' row, court, class, etc.

<u>Photo Release Form</u>: The photographer who takes a picture (of anything or anyone) must sign a release form.
