Lady Alicia's Cookery Booke: Viking Deviled Eggs

It's quiet around the Manor. There is no "Month of Maying" going on – the servants are less boisterous than they usually are when Autumn starts and barely whisper when they speak to me. We are a house in mourning. It is too quiet and too sad, so I decided to make something special today to remember our Baroness.

These eggs were a favorite of Her Excellency (and His Excellency, too) and any time I served them on a dayboard, I would have to make a second, hidden plate just for them. I share this recipe with you so that you can enjoy them too.

Did the Vikings really have deviled eggs? Probably not, but that is the creatively anachronistic part of our game, right? The Vikings left no cookery or receipt-books. From ongoing archaeological analysis of cesspits and dump sites we know the Vikings ate eggs of seabirds, so eggs were part of the diet. They also used fresh herbs whilst they were in season, so wild mustard was available. Arugula adds peppery bite – while Vikings may have "acquired" black pepper, it was not native to their homelands, so arugula fills that space. Horseradish was fresh in season and preserved for the colder months. Finally, Vikings preserved their milk rather than drink it fresh, most often as skyr.

All of the above are pretty much the elements of the classic deviled egg recipe. So I created a recipe that was true to Viking ingredients, possibly a little derivative of process, but pretty darn delicious.

"Viking" Eggs

12 Eggs

1 C Skyr (or whole-fat Greek Yogurt)

1 C. Arugula, minced

4 T Dried Mustard

2T Fresh Ground Horseradish

Milk as/if needed

Salt, to taste



1. Boil eggs until hard-boiled. Cool in ice water until handleable.
2. Mince arugula until almost a paste.
3. Peel eggs, split and pop yolks into a separate bowl. Reserve whites.

4. Add skyr/yogurt, arugula, horseradish, salt and mustard to yolks. Mix thoroughly. If it needs thinning, add milk.
5. The amounts listed are a standard, so add or reduce the seasoning as your taste palate prefers.
6. Fill the egg white halves with the yolk filling and serve.

1. The image is portrait-style
2. The photograph is taken in a private space at an event (such as a personal encampment)
3. The photograph is taken at a non-public venue (such as an armor-making workshop at a home)

No model release form is needed when the photograph is taken at a public place and in a public forum (where there is no expectation of privacy), including: any SCA contest or competition, merchants' row, court, class, etc.

[Photo Release Form](#): The photographer who takes a picture (of anything or anyone) must sign a release form.
