Baronial Meeting Notes, January 18, 2026

The meeting opened at 7:01 p.m. 16 adults were present.

Officers' Reports:

Seneschal

Lady Teleri Barod / J. Lennon

- Quarterly report has been turned in
- Warrant needs to be renewed.
- Seeking deputy/next Seneschal.
- Baronial Polling process: Reached out to Regional Seneschal.
- The Kingdom Seneschal made an announcement about wet/dry sites.
 - PLEASE make sure that your event flyer mentions whether alcohol is allowed or not. Don't just use "Wet" or "Dry" – specifically state if alcohol is prohibited.
 - We are considering some options for Gate for events with signage and an acknowledgment where alcohol is prohibited.
 - Remember, Event Stewards are deputies of the Seneschal's office. They have the ability to boot someone from the site if need be. If a person is discovered to have alcohol at a site where alcohol is prohibited, the Event Steward should tell them they have to leave IMMEDIATELY. The Kingdom Seneschal does not care who they are or what kind of pointy hat they have. Anyone who violates the "No Alcohol on site" rule is to be removed at once. If they refuse, call Law Enforcement and have them removed.
 - The group seneschal of the hosting group also has that authority.
 - The Kingdom Seneschal will back the local group seneschal 100%, and so will the Society Seneschal.
 - This is a non-negotiable thing. People bringing alcohol to no-alcohol sites will be removed immediately, and may very well face additional sanctions. We cannot afford to lose sites because someone thought they were above the rules.
 - If the local seneschal or the event steward has to take this action, please notify the Kingdom Seneschal immediately, and follow it up with a full writeup of exactly what happened.

- Not showing on the website – has been Spiked. Teleri will check with the Calendar Deputy.
- We still need an event steward!
- Morgan can do field organization and layout.

Battle on the Bay 2006

- The dates will be October 23-25, 2026. Teleri said she thinks that Lochmere (who is in charge of this year's event) will be having a planning meeting this week.

2027 Dates for Novice and BotB

- Looking at April 16-18, 2027. Zarra moved to approve \$1600 for rental, Teleri seconded, motion passed.
- Battle on the Bay 2027: September 10-12, 2027. Teleri moved to approve \$1600 for rental, Zarra seconded, motion passed.

LEAFs 2027

- Highland Foorde would like to co-sponsor this event with us again at the Croom site. Epy Pengelly, Armiger, is the event steward. There will be different rates for attending the whole event and for attending just on Saturday.
- How early can we reserve Croom? HF would like to hold LEAFs in May. Orla will check with Tirzah.
- Vote to approve \$1550 for our half of the budget. Teleri made the motion, Zarra seconded, motion approved. Intend to ask Highland Foorde for only \$200 out of \$800 equestrian insurance, but we are leaving the \$400 in the budget in case the 2027 insurance cost goes up. There is a possibility that LEAFs could be the next Highland Foorde investiture; if it is, more people will attend and we may need more portajohns.

[Grant of Use Form](#): For articles, non-photograph artwork, most other contributions

[Model Release Form](#): People appearing in photographs must sign this if:

1. The image is portrait-style
2. The photograph is taken in a private space at an event (such as a personal encampment)
3. The photograph is taken at a non-public venue (such as an armor-making workshop at a home)

No model release form is needed when the photograph is taken at a public place and in a public forum (where there is no expectation of privacy), including: any SCA contest or competition, merchants' row, court, class, etc.

[Photo Release Form](#): The photographer who takes a picture (of anything or anyone) must sign a release form.
